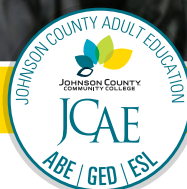

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JOHNSON COUNTY ADULT BASIC EDUCATION

ADULT BASIC EDUCATION COURSES CAN HELP YOU WITH:

- Basic skills in reading, writing and math
- Test preparation for the General Educational Development (GED®) test
- The creation of a study plan for your individualized learning
- Computer and work-ready skills

WHY ATTEND?

- Class size is small, with friendly people who are also seeking skills to improve their lives.
- A transition coach will assist you with your future plans.
- Professional instructors and volunteers provide you with one-on-one attention.

WHO CAN ATTEND?

Programs are designed for individuals age 16 and older who are no longer in school.

- If you are age 16 or 17, you will need to provide a high school attendance disclaimer from the public high school in the school district where you currently live. *(Contact the school's administrative offices for this document.)*



JCAE GUARANTEE SCHOLARSHIP

If you enroll and complete your GED® through JCAE, you will receive a \$600 scholarship to JCCC to be used within one year of passing your final GED® exam.

OFFICIAL GED® TEST

Official tests are administered at a Pearson VUE testing center only. After successful completion of the test, you will be awarded a Kansas high school diploma.

If you are planning to take the GED® exam, you will need government-issued identification with a photograph such as a passport or driver's license.

Required at registration

- A \$60 nonrefundable registration fee for materials, paid by credit/debit card (preferred). NO CASH ACCEPTED.
- A high school attendance disclaimer if you are 16 or 17 years old *(Contact the school's administrative offices for this document.)*
