The Associate of Arts degree (A.A.) at JCCC is a general transfer degree and partners well with the first two years of most bachelor degree programs. Students pursuing the A.A. may select courses that satisfy both the A.A. degree requirements and lower division requirements for a bachelor's degree at four-year institutions. The elective hours within the A.A. allow students to complete additional general education and lower division courses required for specific majors. The A.A. degree requires completion of 60 credit hours. Completion of the JCCC A.A. or A.S. (Associate of Science) degree satisfies KU Core Goals 1, 2 and 3. JCCC degree requirements can be found at: <http://catalog.jccc.edu/degree/requirements/>. A maximum of 75 community college credit hours can be applied toward a bachelor's degree at KU Edwards. Contact your KU Edwards academic success coach for more information. **Meeting with a JCCC counselor is strongly recommended for selection of appropriate courses at JCCC.**

Three Degree Options

The Environmental Studies program at KU Edwards offers three degree options. For the BA and the BGS, the major requirements are identical and require 40 credit hours, but degree requirements differ. See the BA and BGS degree requirements below. For the BS degree, the major requires 68 hours and degree requirements are different from the BA or BGS. See the BS degree requirements below. All students must satisfy the KU Core, KU's general education program.

Admission

Transfer students <https://admissions.ku.edu/> and should be sure to select the Edwards Campus. Students must have a 2.5 transferable GPA with 24 completed college hours for admission as a transfer. The transferable GPA includes all courses that are normally transferable to KU. Though only transfer grades of "C" or higher will count toward KU degree requirements, all grades count in the transferable GPA.

Graduation Requirements

Students must earn 120 hours for graduation, of which 45 must be upper division. Thirty of the hours must be at KU. Community college courses do not transfer as junior/senior hours. Students must satisfy the KU Core; the BA, BGS, or BS requirements; all courses in the major; and enough electives to total 120 hours.

It is the STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY to check for updates to all transfer information. This transfer guide is provided as a service and is updated as needed. Degree requirements at the four-year colleges are subject to change by those institutions. To ensure you have the most accurate up to date information about the program, it is imperative you meet with an advisor at the transfer institution.

KU Core Requirements

The KU Core is KU's general education program. It is a set of six educational goals that all students must satisfy. Students should complete these requirements at JCCC when possible. Some of these may be covered by major courses as noted below in the major requirements below. Completion of the JCCC A.A. or A.S. degree satisfies KU Core Goals 1, 2 and 3. Bachelor of General Studies (BGS) in Environmental Studies

In addition to the KU Core and the courses in the major, the BGS requires an upper-level career preparation course which is fulfilled by the environmental studies capstone course. The BGS also requires a second area of study (one of: additional major, co-major, minor, two certificates). If students know the minor they wish to pursue, up to six hours may be taken at the community college, but students should consult a KU Edwards academic success coach.
