

Steps to Enroll for SUMMER 2024

SUMMER Open Enrollment begins April 3 ONLINE!

Enroll from the comfort of home! Open enrollment begins April 3 at 9 p.m. online. To prepare, log in to MyJCCC and check for holds that would prevent enrollment. Use the credit class search to view the class schedule and any required prerequisites. Check your unofficial transcript in MyJCCC to be sure you have the required prerequisites for courses you plan to enroll in. Learn more at jccc.edu/enroll.

- 1. Apply for Admission.** When your application is processed, you'll get an email that includes your JCCC ID number and MyJCCC login information.
 - Log in to complete your personal admission plan before enrolling in classes.
 - Register your email and change your password.
- 2. Apply for Financial Aid** online at fafsa.gov using JCCC school code 008244.
 - Log into MyJCCC to complete financial aid requirements and check status.
 - Complete requirements by **April 15** to have an offer by the payment deadline.
 - Accepted financial aid will protect enrollment until funds disburse.

Apply for JCCC Scholarships online.
- 3. Attend New Student Orientation.** If you are a **first-time college student** you must attend new student orientation before you can enroll. Learn more and register online.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS: New or transfer I-20 students must contact the International and Immigrant Student Services Office for F-1 orientation requirements and important deadlines. Visit jccc.edu/iiss for more details.
- 4. Fulfill Placement Requirements.**
 - Some courses require prerequisite coursework or placement prior to enrollment.
 - Visit the Prerequisites and Placement webpage for information on placement requirements. If you need disability accommodation for the placement test, contact Access Services.♦
- 5. Meet with a Counselor** for academic advising, transfer information, personal and/or career counseling. Call 913-469-3809 or visit the Counseling webpage for an appointment.
- 6. Enroll in Classes** by logging in to your MyJCCC account. *See reverse for enrollment dates.*
 - Course has a prerequisite? See Step 4 online for details.
 - Class closed? Waitlisting may be an option.
- 7. Pay Tuition** by 6 p.m. on May 28, 2024 by logging into MyFinances.
 - Check out ways to pay on the Tuition webpage.

If you do not pay by the deadline, you risk being dropped from your classes.
- 8. Get your Student ID Card** at the Student Engagement Desk, (SC, 1st floor) or the Billington Library (LIB, 2nd floor). Be sure to bring your driver's license or other photo ID with you. You qualify for an ID after your tuition is paid through third-party billing, financial aid, enrollment in a payment plan or paid in full by you.
- 9. Purchase Textbooks** through the JCCC Bookstore in store or online starting April 29. The early bird discount runs from April 29-May 17. Textbook rentals are due back no later than July 26, 2024.

MARCH

1 Summer schedule of classes becomes available on the web.

APRIL

1-3 **Summer pre-enrollment** begins at 8 a.m. for students who have applied for graduation or are required to enroll in a developmental education course. Career program students are also eligible to enroll at this time (excludes Liberal Arts, Fine Arts, General Sciences, General Studies and non-degree seeking students).

3 **Open enrollment for summer** begins at 9 p.m. on the web.

5 Enrollment for summer CNA courses (AVHO 102) begins at 8 a.m.

MAY

3 New and readmitted students are encouraged to apply by this date to ensure enrollment by the start of the summer semester.

27 Memorial Day holiday. College offices closed.

28 **Payment deadline—6 p.m.** All students enrolling prior to this deadline must pay tuition and fees by 6 p.m. or risk being dropped from classes. Enrollment will be closed from 6 to 9 p.m. for drop for non-payment processing. Payment is due on the date of enrollment for students adding classes after the payment deadline.

28 Web enrollment reopens at 9 p.m.

31 Credit enrollment for students eligible for the 60+ tuition rate begins at 8 a.m.

JUNE

3 **First day of 8-week courses and first 4-week courses of summer session.**

3 **Enrollment Reminder:** students must be enrolled in a course no later than the first day the course meets.

5 Last day to drop a first 4-week course and receive a refund.

10 Last day to drop an 8-week course and receive a refund.

10 Last day to drop a first 4-week course without a withdrawal "W" on the student's permanent record.

14 Last day to drop an 8-week course without a withdrawal "W" on the student's permanent record. Deadline is 11 p.m. for drops completed on the web.

17 Application deadline for summer graduation.

21 Last day to request a pass/fail grade option or to withdraw with a "W" from a first 4-week course.

27 **Last day of first 4-week courses of summer session. Final exams are held on the last day of each course unless otherwise specified by the instructor.***

**Due to the length of the final exam for some courses, students may be required to attend class on the Friday following the last day of the session to take their final exam.*

JULY

1 **First day of second 4-week courses of summer session.**

3 Last day to drop a second 4-week course and receive a refund.

4 Independence Day holiday. College closed.

8 Last day to drop a second 4-week course without a withdrawal "W" on the student's permanent record.

15 Last day to request a pass/fail grade option or to withdraw with a "W" from an 8-week course.

19 Last day to request a pass/fail grade option or to withdraw with a "W" from a second 4-week course.

25 **Last day of 8-week courses and second 4-week courses of summer session. Final exams are held on the last day of each course unless otherwise specified by the instructor.***

**Due to the length of the final exam for some courses, students may be required to attend class on the Friday following the last day of the session to take their final exam.*

29 Final grades entered online by professors by 5 p.m.

31 Grades available to students by noon on the web.
