The Associate of Arts degree (A.A.) at JCCC is a general transfer degree and partners well with the first two years of most bachelor degree programs. Students pursuing the A.A. may select courses that satisfy both the A.A. degree requirements and lower division requirements for a bachelor's degree at four-year institutions. The elective hours within the A.A. allow students to complete additional general education and lower division courses required for specific majors. The A.A. degree requires completion of 60 credit hours; please see [JCCC A.A. degree requirements](#). Meeting with a JCCC counselor is strongly recommended for selection of appropriate courses.

### **Admission Requirements**

- Apply for admission, including \$20 application fee (non-refundable). Complete the application on-line at [washburn.edu/admissions](http://washburn.edu/admissions).

### **Requirements for Bachelor's Degree**

- Minimum of 120 semester hours of credit
- Minimum 2.0 G.P.A.
- Minimum of 60 semester hours from Washburn or a four-year college or university; at least 30 hours must be completed through Washburn
- Minimum of 45 semester hours of credit from courses at the upper division level
- Minimum of 84 graded hours
- Grade of "C" or better in courses counting towards the university core, major, correlate, and minor requirements
- At least 50 percent of the major hours used to meet requirements for the BBA degree must be earned at Washburn
- 51 hours of General Education Credit

### **Requirements for Admissions to the School of Business**

- 60 hours of College Credit
- The following Lower Core Business courses with a "C" or better:  
AC 224 Financial Accounting, AC 225 Managerial Accounting, BU 248 Foundations of Data Analysis, BU 250 Management Information Systems, EC 200 Principles of Microeconomics, EC 201 Principles of Macroeconomics, and EC 211 Statistics for Business and Economics.
