The Associate of Arts degree (A.A.) at JCCC is a general transfer degree and partners well with the first two years of most bachelor degree programs. Students pursuing the A.A. may select courses that satisfy both the A.A. degree requirements and lower division requirements for a bachelor's degree at four-year institutions. The elective hours within the A.A. allow students to complete additional general education and lower division courses required for specific majors. The A.A. degree requires completion of 60 credit hours. Completion of the JCCC A.A. (or A.S. Associate of Science) degree satisfies KU Core Goals 1, 2 and 3. Meeting with a JCCC counselor is strongly recommended for selection of appropriate courses.

The Bachelor of Professional Studies (BPS) program is designed for undergraduate students with a strong interest in practical training in professional management career pathways. The BPS degree is a professional track baccalaureate completion degree for students transferring to KU with an associate degree or equivalent hours and who are looking to complete the last two years necessary for a bachelor's degree. A maximum of 75 community college credit hours can be applied toward a bachelor's degree at KU Edwards. Contact your KU Edwards academic success coach for more information. Meeting with a JCCC counselor is strongly recommended for selection of appropriate courses.

# Students in the BPS program choose a concentration that aligns with their professional goals in the areas of:

- Applied Data Analytics
- Health Policy and Management
- Project Management

### **Admission requirements:**

- Review KU admission requirements and apply online at <u>admissions.ku.edu</u>. International transfer students submit a KU application through International Admissions at <u>world.ku.edu</u>. Submit an official transcript form each college you've attended. Must apply to KU Edwards Campus and be admitted by the School of Professional Studies.
- Minimum cumulative transferable GPA of 2.50. A transferable GPA includes all courses that KU will accept for transfer. Though only transfer grades of "C" or higher will count toward KU degree requirements, all grades count in the transferable GPA.
- Must complete two years of undergraduate college course work with a total of 60 semester credit hours.

Minimum total hours for graduation is 120, of which 45 must be upper division, with at least 30 in residence at KU. Community college courses do not transfer as junior/senior hours.

## **Bachelor of Professional Studies**

### **KU Core Requirements**

The KU Core is KU's general education program. It is a set of six educational goals that all students must satisfy. As noted below, the General Education Requirements specified by the Bachelor of Professional Studies degree satisfy KU Core Goals 1.2, 2.1, and 2.2. Students may also complete the KU Core Goals 1.1, 3H, 3N, 3S, 4.1, 4.2, and 5.1 at JCCC as listed in the table below.

Completion of the JCCC A.A. (or A.S.) degree satisfies KU Core Goals 1, 2 and 3. Students should work with their JCCC counselor to ensure they are meeting <u>JCCC degree requirements</u>. Students not completing the A.A. (or A.S.) degree may refer to <a href="https://credittransfer.ku.edu/">https://credittransfer.ku.edu/</a> to see how JCCC courses will transfer to meet KU Core Goals.
