The Associate of Arts degree (A.A.) at JCCC is a general transfer degree and partners well with the first two years of most bachelor degree programs. Students pursuing the A.A. may select courses that satisfy both the A.A. degree requirements and lower division requirements for a bachelor's degree at four-year institutions. The elective hours within the A.A. allow students to complete additional general education and lower division courses required for specific majors. The A.A. degree requires completion of 60 credit hours. Completion of the JCCC A.A. (or A.S. Associate of Science) degree satisfies KU Core Goals 1, 2 and 3. Meeting with a JCCC counselor is strongly recommended for selection of appropriate courses.

## KU Edwards offers two degree options for Project Management. Both degrees are online and may be started in any term including summer.

- The Bachelor of Science (BS) in Project Management
- The Bachelor of Applied Science (BAS) in Project Management

As you complete your project management bachelor's degree online with KU, you will be able to partner the project management foundation courses with additional emphasis area courses to tailor your education to your desired career path. Some majors at JCCC pair well with the required emphasis, such as business, healthcare, sciences, computer-related areas including design, architecture, web-design, and marketing. For guidance and approval of emphasis area courses, please speak with the Academic Success Coach at KU Edwards Campus.

#### The following admission requirement applies to both degree options:

- Minimum cumulative transferable GPA of 2.50. A transferable GPA includes all courses that KU will accept for transfer. Though only transfer grades of "C" or higher will count toward KU degree requirements, all grades count in the transferable GPA.
- Review KU admission requirements and apply online at <u>admissions.ku.edu</u>. International transfer students submit a KU application through International Admissions at <u>world.ku.edu</u>. Submit an official transcript form each college you've attended. Must apply to KU Edwards Campus and be admitted by the School of Professional Studies.

Minimum total hours for graduation is 120, of which 45 must be upper division. Community college courses do not transfer as junior/senior hours. Thirty of the 120 hours must be at KU.

## **Bachelor of Science in Project Management**

#### **KU Core Requirements**

The KU Core is KU's general education program. It is a set of six educational goals that all students must satisfy. As noted below, the General Education Requirements specified by the Project Management BS degree in the School of Professional Studies satisfy KU Core Goals 1.2, 2.1, 2.2, 3S, and 3N, and Goal 6 is satisfied by an upper-level major course. Students may also complete the KU Core Goals 1.1, 3H, 4.1, 4.2, and 5.1 at JCCC as listed in the table below.
