



**MWSU Early Childhood Admission Requirements**

- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 or greater maintained through graduation and 3.0 GPA in Content Area and Teacher Education.
- Completed or course equivalency to EDU 202 - Intro to Education (EDUC 121 at JCCC) and EDU 203 Participation in Teaching (EDUC 260 at JCCC).
- Missouri General Education Assessment (MOGEA) passing scores in all 4 sub-tests. (Reading – 202, Writing – 193, Math – 180, Science/Social Studies – 188).
- Pre-major and/or major declaration form and concentration form on file.

Students must complete General Studies courses in addition to the major requirements. Please refer to the [General Studies](#) guide for requirements and JCCC equivalents.
