

# Steps to Enroll for SPRING 2024

## SPRING Open Enrollment begins Oct. 25 ONLINE!

Enroll from the comfort of home! Open enrollment begins Oct. 25 at 9 p.m. online. To prepare, log in to MyJCCC and check for holds that would prevent enrollment. Use the credit class search to view the class schedule and any required prerequisites. Check your unofficial transcript in MyJCCC to be sure you have the required prerequisites for courses you plan to enroll in. Learn more at [jccc.edu/enroll](https://jccc.edu/enroll).

- 1. Apply for Admission.** When your application is processed, you'll get an email that includes your JCCC ID number and MyJCCC login information.
  - Log in to complete your personal admission plan before enrolling in classes.
  - Register your email and change your password.
- 2. Apply for Financial Aid** online at [fafsa.gov](https://fafsa.gov) using JCCC school code 008244.
  - Log into MyJCCC to complete financial aid requirements and check status.
  - Complete requirements by **November 15** to have an offer by the payment deadline.
  - Accepted financial aid will protect enrollment until funds disburse.

**Apply for JCCC Scholarships** online.
- 3. Attend New Student Orientation.** If you are a **first-time college student** you must attend new student orientation before you can enroll. Learn more and register online.
 

**INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS:** New or transfer I-20 students must contact the International and Immigrant Student Services Office for F-1 orientation requirements and important deadlines. Visit [jccc.edu/iiss](https://jccc.edu/iiss) for more details.
- 4. Fulfill Placement Requirements.**
  - Some courses require prerequisite coursework or placement prior to enrollment.
  - Visit the Prerequisites and Placement webpage for information on placement requirements. If you need disability accommodation for the placement test, contact Access Services.♦
- 5. Meet with a Counselor** for academic advising, transfer information, personal and/or career counseling. Call 913-469-3809 or visit the Counseling webpage for an appointment.
- 6. Enroll in Classes** by logging in to your MyJCCC account. *See reverse for enrollment dates.*
  - Course has a prerequisite? See Step 4 online for details.
  - Class closed? Waitlisting may be an option.
- 7. Pay Tuition** by 6 p.m. on January 9, 2024 through MyFinances in your MyJCCC account.
  - Check out ways to pay on the Tuition webpage.

**If you do not pay by the deadline, you risk being dropped from your classes.**
- 8. Get your Student ID Card** at the Student Engagement Desk, (SC, 1st floor) or the Billington Library (LIB, 2nd floor). Be sure to bring your driver's license or other photo ID with you. You qualify for an ID after your tuition is paid through third-party billing, financial aid, enrollment in a payment plan or paid in full by you.
- 9. Purchase Textbooks** through the JCCC Bookstore in store or online starting November 27. The early bird discount runs from November 27–December 21. Textbook rentals are due back no later than May 14.

## SEPTEMBER 2023

15 Spring schedule of classes becomes available on the web.

## OCTOBER

23-25 **Spring pre-enrollment** begins at 8 a.m. for students who have applied for graduation or are required to enroll in a developmental education course. Career program students are also eligible to enroll at this time (excludes Liberal Arts, Fine Arts, General Sciences, General Studies and non-degree seeking students).

25 **Open enrollment begins on the web at 9 p.m. for spring classes!**

27 Enrollment for spring CNA courses (AVHO 102) begins at 8 a.m.

## DECEMBER

1 New and readmitted students are encouraged to apply by this date to ensure enrollment by the start of the spring semester.

22-Jan. 1 Winter break. College closed.

## JANUARY 2024

2 Staff on 10-month contract return.

9 Staff on 9-month contract return.

9 **Payment deadline — 6 p.m.** All students enrolling prior to this deadline must pay tuition and fees by 6 p.m. or risk being dropped from classes. Enrollment will be closed from 6 to 9 p.m. for drop for nonpayment processing. Payment is due on the date of enrollment for students adding classes after the payment deadline.

9 Web enrollment reopens at 9 p.m.

9-12 Professional development days for faculty. College offices open.

12 Credit enrollment for students eligible for the 60+ tuition rate begins at 8 a.m.

15 Martin Luther King Jr. Day. College closed.

16 **First day of spring credit classes.**

16-17 **Late registration:** after these dates, students must be enrolled in a course no later than the first day the course meets.

23 Last day to drop a full-semester course and receive a 100% refund.

## FEBRUARY

12 Last day to drop a full-semester course without a withdrawal “W” on the student’s permanent record. Deadline is 11 p.m. for drops completed on the web.

15 Application deadline to apply for spring graduation.

## MARCH

11-17 Spring Break. Classes not in session. College offices open Monday through Friday.

## APRIL

15 Last day to request a pass/fail grade option or to withdraw with a “W” from a full semester course.

## MAY

1 Deadline for faculty to submit grade changes for “I” grades assigned in the fall semester.

5 Last day of spring instruction.

6 Stop Day. College offices open. Final exams for Monday evening classes only.

7-13 Scheduled final exams for students.

11 Saturday classes end.

12 Sunday classes end.

13 Last day of spring semester.

13-17 In-Service Days. College offices open.

14 Grades entered online by professors by 5 p.m.

16 Grades available to students by noon on the web.

17 Commencement.

17 Last day for staff on 9-month contract.

24 Last day for staff on 10-month contract.

27 Memorial Day Holiday. College offices closed.
