Police Academy Location:

The Johnson County Regional Police Academy is located on the campus of Johnson County Community College (12345 College Blvd, Overland Park, KS 66210). The training facility is located on the NW side of campus, on Campus Drive, south of the College Blvd and Westgate entrance. Recruits should park in the parking lot on the west side of the building; refrain from parking along the south side. Orientation will be held in classroom **PA 124**.

Attendance:

Police Academy recruits shall attend all training sessions. Although emergencies do occasionally arise, absences should be kept to an absolute minimum. Recruits shall obtain prior approval from Academy staff prior to scheduling non-emergency activities.

College Credit:

During Orientation, all Police Academy recruits will be registered as students at Johnson County Community College and are eligible to receive 12 credit hours within the Administration of Justice curriculum. Veterans may be eligible for education benefits, and they should discuss this with college personnel during the registration process.
